

Practice writing

Quick help



With your stylus, make a line from the bottom of your screen to the top. The Graffiti 2 Help screen appears. Use the navigator to scroll up and down to find the strokes for the character you want to write.

Spaces and other characters

Make a space by drawing a short horizontal line from left to right. Erase by drawing the same line backwards. For a line return, make a slash from the upper-right to lower-left corner.

With a little practice, you'll quickly get the hang of writing letters, numbers, and punctuation.

Improve your accuracy

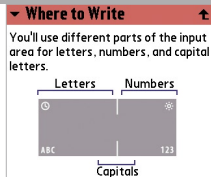
Watch your stylus as you write to make fewer errors.

Quick reference

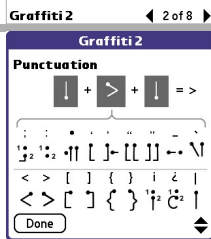
Apply the Graffiti 2 stickers that came with your handheld to the inside of your handheld's cover.

Capitals and special characters

1 Write lowercase letters on the left side of the writing area and numbers on the right side. To write capital letters, use the middle of the writing area.



2 Create special characters by drawing an upward stroke, the special character, and another upward stroke.

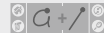
